What is the ITXpress program?

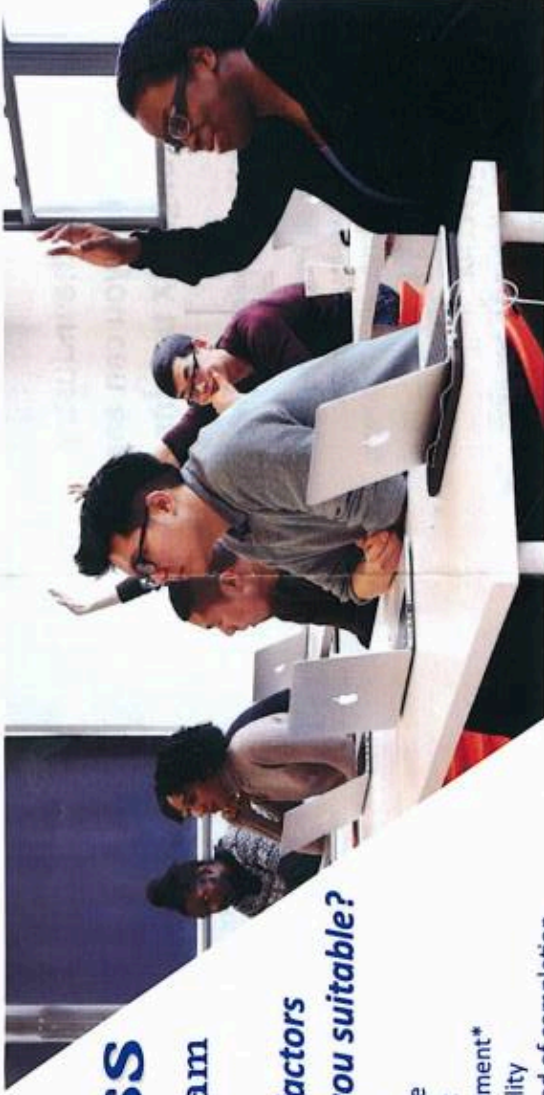
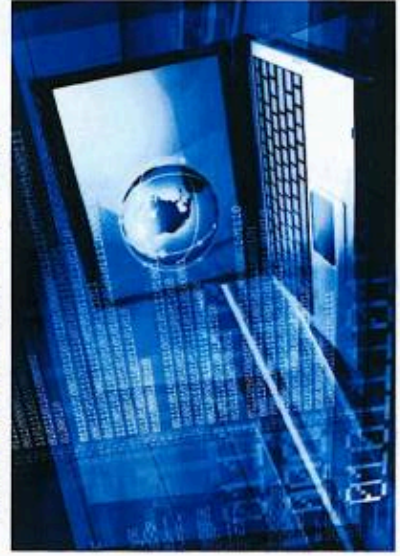
The program provides no-cost customizable training and support services to young adults age 17-29 with an aim to help connect them to jobs in the Information Technology field.

Depending on the individual this program may include:

- Online training
- Boot-camp training
- Internships
- Apprenticeships
- Transportation
- Childcare assistance

What are the requirements?

- must be between the ages of 17-29
- a U.S. citizen
- out of school
- unemployed/underemployed
- must have a barrier to employment



What factors make you suitable?

- aptitude
- interest
- commitment*
- availability
- likelihood of completion

Training for high paying careers

such as:

- Software Developer
- Computer and Information Systems Manager
- Computer Systems Analyst
- Computer User Support Specialist
- Computer Programmer
- CyberSecurity Specialist

What support will you receive?

To help participants succeed, ITXpress has enlisted the support of training partners from Connecticut's public colleges and universities as well as local training programs.

ITXpress has also enlisted the support of employers such as IBM, Cigna, NewOak Capital LLC, and the Connecticut Technology Council.

* Training will require a three to six month full time commitment.

Participants who successfully complete training will receive recognized credentials in the IT industry. Follow up support will be provided to help participants secure employment.
